#### Job Purpose:

#### Key Tasks / Responsibilities:

- 1. Plan and deliver a teaching/learning programme using a flexible range of strategies and learning styles and taking responsibility for the quality of own teaching.
- 2. Set, mark and record students' work including assessment and internal verification as necessary, and preparing work to the level of examination(s).
- 3. Accurately maintain class registers, schemes of work, College forms and records and any other administrative work, and submit returns as required by the Programme Area Manager.
- 4. Work within an agreed curriculum framework and to agreed targets/objectives, and contribute to department curriculum development activities.
- 5. Check and authorise student examination entries and notify students of relevant dates.
- 6. Participate in course/subject team meetings, course/subject and curriculum development, and course review and evaluation.
- 7. Keep abreast of curriculum developments.
- 8. Manage the behaviour of students
- 9. In certain circumstances the following may be required:
  - a. Accompany students on educational and residential visits in this country or abroad.
  - b. Take responsibility for a particular area of the work of the Programme Area.
- 10. Other duties commensurate with the grade of post as required.
